2. To the thief who asked to be remembered when Jesus came into His kingdom He said, ***“Truly I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise.”***
3. When Jesus saw His mother and the disciple He loved standing nearby, He said to His mother, ***“Woman, behold your son.”*** And to the disciple He said, ***“Behold, Your mother.”***
4. ***“I am thirsty.”***
5. ***“My God, my God, why have you forsaken Me.”***
6. ***“It--is--finished.”***
7. ***“Father, into Your hands I commit My Spirit.”***
